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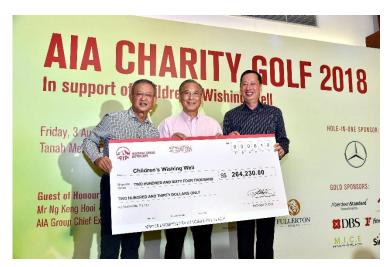

The funds raised is to help children from low-income families to improve their quality of life. It will be used to purchase groceries for needy families, fund enrichment programmes to support children in their studies, as well as setting up of a bursary fund.

They aim to build a strong foundation for the children to contribute as useful members of society and live fulfilling lives. They provide a wide range of services, including "Career GPS" which exposes students to different career options and encourage them to work towards their goals, through internship, job shadowing, and/or mentorship.

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together for this meaningful purpose of raising funds for Children's Wishing Well.
