Protection against Phishing attacks & un-authorised access

MFA adds an additional layer of defense against phishing attacks which hackers use to obtain your credentials. They will need additional authentication factor to access your account.



Mitigation of Password Vulnerabilities

MFA helps to address the vulnerabilities associated with passwords. Weak or easily guessable passwords become less of a concern as an attacker would need the additional authentication factor to bypass the MFA protection.

Here are tips to help you get started.

1. Activate MFA for services that contain sensitive information and can be used to impersonate you.

Social network accounts such as Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn etc Email services and mobile devices such as Google, Microsoft, Apple

 Keep your account information up to date.
When setting up a new phone, third party authenticator and bank applications also require reregistration of the MFA to ensure your accounts are secure.
